### Introduction

The purpose of this 3000-word case study is to encourage you to demonstrate your knowledge, skills and ability to meet the public health needs of a woman in your care. To do this you will need to select a woman within your caseload and reflect on this. This should include consideration of her needs, the midwifery goals, evidence-based care given and the outcomes to demonstrate how you achieved a woman-centred care approach.

The case study should be structured by identifying a public health issue and, using a health promotion framework, critically analyse the care you have given using relevant theories to support your discussion.

### Assessment Criteria

Your work will be marked using the following criteria, so you must ensure you address these in your work, taking into consideration the percentage each criterion is worth of the overall mark and the grade related criteria that are in your programme handbook.

#### **Demonstrate logical, coherent development in your essay. It must be clearly presented.**

The essay must reflect the grade related criteria regarding content. It should include an introduction and a conclusion (you may choose to use headings). You should allocate the number of words per section according to the marks available.

#### **Provide accurate and up to date references using the Harvard referencing system.**

#### **Clearly identify the public health issue from your case study.**

You need to present a brief outline of your case study and then indicate what the Public Health issue is and its impact on your client's health.

#### **Using Health Promotion Frameworks critically analyse the woman's needs and midwifery care involved.**

You need to explore different Health Promotion Frameworks and how these can be used to focus the care your client requires i.e. that address her particular needs. Therefore, you should choose an appropriate framework to demonstrate how her needs have been met. Care may not have addressed your client's individual needs and you can reflect on this using the framework as guidance.

#### **Identify and critically discuss Health Promotion and other theories that influence midwifery practice.**

There are a number of theories which impact on the way Midwifery is practiced e.g. Ethical – autonomy and consent; Biological basis of health; Attachment and bonding; Medical model of care or the Midwifery model of Care (these are given as examples only). Your discussion should demonstrate your understanding of how your chosen theories can influence your practice and the outcome of care.

**Use appropriate and relevant supporting literature and research.**

Your module handbook will list all relevant literature for this assignment; however, you are encouraged to explore the literature further in order to present a well balanced discussion surrounding your topic.
