



The Lord Mayor of London Scholarships at City University London

City University London is offering a Scholarship of up to **£3,000** per year to UK and EU undergraduate students achieving grades AAB or above at A-level (or equivalent) starting an undergraduate course at City in September 2012.

At City we believe that exceptional academic performance should be recognised and rewarded. Achieve AAB or above in your A-levels (or equivalent) and we will offer you a Lord Mayor of London Scholarship of up to £3,000 a year for at least three years. UK and EU students starting an undergraduate course of study at City in 2012/13 are eligible. The award will be granted subject to confirmation of your A-level results (or equivalent qualifications).

You will receive the Scholarship if you reach the required standard in your three best A-levels (or equivalent qualifications). Its value varies according to your grades and course but you may spend the money as you wish. The award extends over three or four years (with the exception of any placement year) subject to satisfactory academic performance.

You do not need to apply. All qualifying applicants achieving the required grades will automatically be awarded the Scholarship in January 2013 except in the School of Health Sciences where a maximum of 50 Scholarships will be awarded (see terms and conditions).

Notification of Scholarship

Students will be notified of their Scholarships via email to their University email address from Monday 1 October 2012 following confirmation of admission and registration.

Eligibility

To be eligible* for a Lord Mayor of London Scholarship a student must:

- Be a UK or EU student starting on an undergraduate course of study at City in 2012/13
- Have achieved A-level grades of AAB or above (or equivalent qualifications)
- Be registered full-time at the University on Monday 1 October 2012.

Value of Scholarship

The annual value of The Lord Mayor of London Scholarship depends on the course and A-level grades (or equivalent). See the table overleaf.

Payment of Scholarship

Scholarship payments will be made each January following confirmation of A-level results (or equivalent) in year one and of adequate academic progress in subsequent years.

The payment will be made by direct transfer into the student's bank account.

Terms and conditions

All information in this brochure refers to 2012/13 year of entry only.

- 1.** Students must be registered full-time at the University on Monday 1 October 2012 to be eligible to receive The Lord Mayor of London Scholarship. Mature students are eligible. Students who already hold a university bachelor's degree (or equivalent) are not eligible.
- 2.** The Scholarship is available to all undergraduate students from the United Kingdom or the European Union who meet the eligibility requirements.
- 3.** The required qualifications at A-level are AAB or above. General Studies A-level is excluded. Equivalent qualifications are at the discretion of City University London. All qualifications are subject to confirmation.
- 4.** Students may be eligible for additional scholarships. However, students can be awarded either the National Scholarship Programme Award or The Lord Mayor of London Scholarship. For more information please visit our scholarships web page.
- 5.** Scholarships within the School of Health Sciences are limited to 50 applicants and will be awarded to AAA students before AAB and in favour of early applicants.
- 6.** Students planning to do an Erasmus year or a placement year in industry will not be entitled to The Lord Mayor of London Scholarship for that year.
- 7.** Students who withdraw from the University before completion of their studies will be liable to refund to the University the full amount received for that year.
- 8.** The University requires adequate academic performance to award the Scholarship in subsequent years.
- 9.** City University London reserves the right to make changes to the terms and conditions of The Lord Mayor of London Scholarship and these will appear on our website.

Scholarships, loans and grants

From the Government

You will be entitled to:

Tuition Fee Loan

(UK & EU students) A non means-tested repayable loan to cover your tuition fee.

Maintenance Loan

(UK students only) A means-tested repayable loan to help you with living costs.

You may be entitled to:

Maintenance Grant

(UK students only) A means-tested non-repayable grant of up to £3,250.

Do you live in a household where income is less than £16,000?

From the University

You may be entitled to:*

National Scholarship Programme

A £3,000 year one scholarship comprising £2,000 tuition fee waiver plus £1,000 cash transfer for living costs.

From the Government

You will be entitled to:

Maintenance Grant (UK students only)

Will you achieve grades AAB at A-level (or equivalent) in your final examinations?

From the University

You will be entitled to:**

A Lord Mayor of London Scholarship

A cash payment of up to £3,000 a year.

Do you meet the criteria for any of City's other scholarships or bursaries?

From the University

You may apply for:

City's undergraduate or school scholarships
