



The City University London Scholarship for Academic Excellence

Supporting you in your studies, City University London is offering a Scholarship of up to **£3,000** per year to UK and EU undergraduate students achieving AAB or above at A-level, or equivalent, starting at City in 2012.

Your exceptional academic performance should be rewarded and recognised. Achieve AAB or above in your A-levels, or equivalent qualifications, and it will be. For those who qualify, our Scholarships offer up to £3,000 a year for at least three years.

To educate future leaders we need able candidates with outstanding grades.

To acknowledge your achievement we have established the City University London Scholarship for Academic Excellence for UK and EU students starting an undergraduate course of study at City in 2012. The award will be granted subject to confirmation of your A-level results or equivalent qualifications.

You will be eligible for up to £3,000 a year if you reach a certain standard in your three best A-levels or equivalent qualifications. The amount of cash awarded varies according to your course but you may spend it as you wish.

This will give you the opportunity to pursue your studies free of financial worries and extends over three or four years subject to satisfactory academic performance with the exception of placement years.

You do not need to apply. All qualifying applicants achieving the required level will automatically be awarded the Scholarship in January 2013 except for those courses offered by our School of Health Sciences where 50 applicants will be awarded the scholarship, allocated in favour of early applicants and AAA students before AAB.

Notification of award

Students will be notified of their awards following confirmation of admission and registration from Monday 1 October 2012 via email to their University email address.

Eligibility

To be eligible* for the City University London Scholarship for Academic Excellence students must:

- Be a UK or EU student starting on an undergraduate course of study at City in 2012
- Have achieved AAB or above in your A-levels or equivalent qualifications
- Be registered full-time at the University on Monday 1 October 2012.

Value of Scholarship

The annual value of the City University London Scholarship for Academic Excellence is set out in the table overleaf and is dependent on the course and A-level or equivalent qualification grades achieved.

Payment of Scholarship

Scholarship payments will be made each January following confirmation of A-level results or equivalent qualifications for year one and confirmation of adequate academic progress for subsequent years.

The payment will be made by a direct transfer into student bank accounts.

Terms and conditions

All information in this brochure refers to 2012 year of entry only.

1. Students must be registered full-time at the University on Monday 1 October 2012 to be eligible to receive this Scholarship. Mature students with the same qualifications as other students will qualify for the same award. Students who already hold a higher education qualification at an equivalent or higher level (e.g. degree or higher) than the qualification they now wish to study are not eligible for this Scholarship.
2. The Scholarship is available to any undergraduate student from the United Kingdom or the European Union who meet the eligibility requirements.
3. The required qualifications at A-level are AAB or above. General Studies A-level is excluded. Equivalent qualifications are at the discretion of City University London. All qualifications are subject to ratification.
4. Students may be eligible for further scholarship packages in addition to the City University London Scholarship for Academic Excellence. However, please note that students can only be awarded either the National Scholarship Programme Award or the City University London Scholarship for Academic Excellence. 5. Scholarships within the School of Health Sciences are limited to 50 applicants and will be awarded in favour of early applicants and AAA students before AAB.
6. Students planning to do an Erasmus year or a placement year in industry will not be entitled to a scholarship for that year.
7. Students who withdraw from the University before completion of their studies will be liable to refund the University with the full amount received for that year.
8. To receive the Scholarship for the length of the course the University requires adequate academic progress throughout.
9. City University London reserve the right to make changes to the terms and conditions of the Scholarship and these will appear on our website.

Scholarships, loans and grants

From the Government

You will be entitled to:

Tuition Fee Loan

(UK & EU students) A non means-tested repayable loan to cover your tuition fee.

Maintenance Loan

(UK students only) A means-tested repayable loan to help you with living costs.

You may be entitled to:

Maintenance Grant

(UK students only) A means-tested non-repayable grant of up to £3,250.

Do you live in a household where income is less than £16,000?

You may be entitled to:*

National Scholarship Programme

A £3,000 year one scholarship comprising £2,000 tuition fee waiver plus £1,000 cash transfer for living costs.
