BAS Therapy Symposium 2022

Online BAS Therapy Symposium 1st-2nd September 2022 on Zoom, hosted by the Division of Language and Communication Science at City, University of London.

The BAS Therapy Symposium is about sharing contemporary and clinically relevant research, clinical experiences, skills and knowledge related to aphasia therapy. Online discussion and written commentary on Zoom will be actively encouraged and supported. The full programme will be announced shortly.

Call for abstracts

The scientific committee of BAS Therapy Symposium 2022 welcomes abstracts on clinically relevant aphasia research and/or practice from any professional background. Abstracts will be independently reviewed by the scientific committee.

Presentation Types

1. Poster

A presentation of your work in poster format (online poster format and practicalities will be determined once submissions have been confirmed).

2. Lightning talk

A 5 minute oral presentation. There will be separate time allocated for online questions and answers.

3. Standard presentation

A 30 minute oral presentation. There will be 15 minutes of discussion after the presentation, moderated and incorporating questions from Zoom chat and live oral questions.

4. Longer presentation

A 45 minute oral presentation. The longer presentation is specifically for those who will present details of therapy/intervention provided as part of research or from clinical practice, particularly newer interventions. Intervention content may be presented in video format (videos of therapy sessions) or by detailed explanation of therapy procedures so that clinicians may acquire knowledge to replicate the intervention. There will be 15 minutes of discussion after the presentation, moderated and incorporating questions from Zoom chat and live oral questions.

Format of submission

Must include title, authors, affiliation, corresponding author and email, and a structured abstract. The word count for the abstract is 500 words max. The title, authors etc and references are not included in the word count. Please list the word count on your submission.

For poster/lightning talk/standard presentation please use the abstract headings: Background/aims, Method, Results, Discussion/Conclusions. For longer presentation please use the abstract headings: Background/aims, Method, Intervention Details, Results, Discussion/Conclusions.

You may add additional headings as suits your abstract and research/clinical practice, but use of the above headings are mandatory.

Please indicate your 1st, 2nd, 3rd preferences for presentation type.

Please note, all speakers and attendees must be current members of BAS on the date that the RUM is held to be eligible to attend the event.
