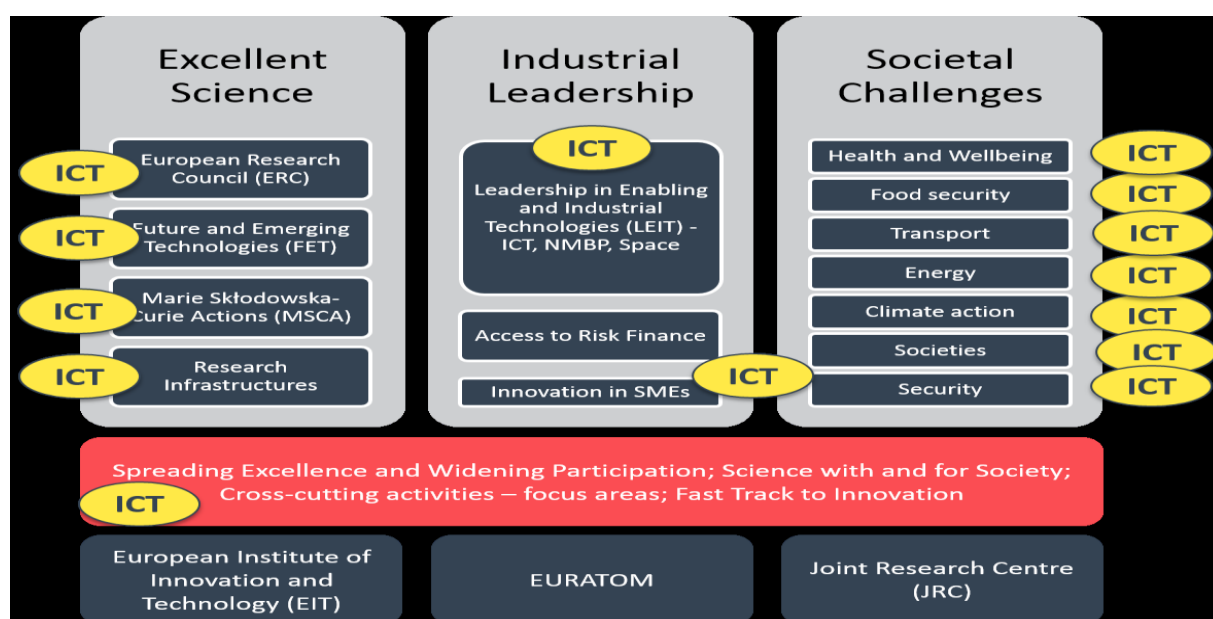


## Funding Opportunities under EU Horizon 2020

City's main target areas under EU Horizon 2020 funding schemes differ between the Schools but cover the followings:

- Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) for the early-stage researchers/PhD training (ITN);
- Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) Individual Fellowships for hosting Post-docs (EF or GF)
- European Research Council (ERC) grants for strengthening our research base, raising institutional profile and to purchase bigger equipment
- Multi-national collaborative schemes, i.e. the “Research & Innovations Actions” opportunities, which is divided by research field, including health, energy, environment, food/sustainable agriculture, security, society and transport.
- ICT and SSH calls, which are mainstreamed across all of H2020, as indicated as below:
