



George Daniels Undergraduate Scholarship

Terms and Conditions

This is a tuition fees Scholarship - no cash award will be made.

1. Students should be registered on a full-time MEng degree* within the School of Mathematics, Computer Science and Engineering at City University London.
**Exceptional students studying a BEng degree may also be considered.*
2. The Scholarship will be awarded to students in the first year of their studies, and subject to academic performance (see point 7), will be awarded in each subsequent year of study to a maximum of 4 years.

Subject to availability of funds in each academic year, the Scholarship may also be awarded to exceptional students in year 2, 3 or 4 of their course

3. The Scholarship will only be available to individuals resident in the UK for 3 years or more prior to starting their course.
4. The Scholarship will be awarded to students demonstrating the highest A-level qualifications (in subjects appropriate to engineering) OR, the highest average mark for the previous year of study.
Financial need will also be considered when making the award.
5. Students planning to take a year out (e.g Erasmus mobility, placement year in industry, etc.) will not be entitled to the Scholarship for that year. The Scholarship will resume when the student returns to full time studies at the University.
6. Students who withdraw from the University before completion of their studies will be liable to repay the full amount received for that year. In the event that for personal reasons study is deferred for a year, the Scholarship will not be paid for that year but may recommence on resumption of studies at the discretion of the University.
7. The University requires continuous academic excellence to award the Scholarship in subsequent years. Students must achieve an average aggregate mark of 70% or higher in each year to retain the Scholarship.
8. Scholarship holders will be required to submit a one-page annual report at the end of each academic year which will be submitted to the Trust.
9. Scholarship holders will be expected to attend at least one donor specific event each year.
10. City, University of London reserves the right to make changes to the terms and conditions of the Scholarship.
