General pre-requisites

Applicants for Level 2000 courses should have a background in the subject area, for example one or two successfully passed university level courses in the subject area or with transferable skills/knowledge. Applicants for Level 3000 courses should be a major in that subject or have extensive knowledge of the subject area.

Availability

Courses listed in **GREEN** and **AMBER** above currently have availability, more so for green courses. Courses with **RED** are currently full, and in most cases, we will place students on a waiting list. Courses listed as **CLOSED** will not accept any more students on the waiting list.

Credit

All courses on the Study Abroad Programme are worth 15 UK credits/7.5 ECTS, and most US universities award 4 US credits. A full load at City is 60 credits.
