Subject: Enterprise Education Updates

1. CitySpark 2016

CitySpark (City's business ideas competition) attracted over 250 applications. The final took place at Cass Business School on 22nd March attracting over 200 attendees. The 5 winners were:

- Twipes (dispersible wet wipes)
- Archtor (Keyboard with LCD keys for customisable gaming)
- Bookball (Booking software for sports venues)
- Eatsafe (an app for food allergy sufferers)
- Binta's Kitchen (a no sugar, gluten free Nigerian sauce)

Each winning team received £3000 and will progress to the 3rd stage of Cityspark, the start-up summer school taking place from the 4th July.

2. The Hangout

The hangout (City University's business incubator space) has received its latest intake of businesses and will be opening again for applications in mid July. Desk space and access to off campus meetings are available to students and alumni of City.

The Hangout will also be relocating prior to the start of new academic year as the current landlord (Unruly) is planning to relocate their business.

3. Made@City

Made@City (City's end of year show celebrating innovation and creativity) will be taking place on the 9th June in the lower ground labs in the Tait building.

Made@City will also provide the venue for 'images of research'.

4. MSc Entrepreneurship

The MSc in Entrepreneurship will launch in September 2016. The course has so far attracted healthy interest.
